

Activity

Memory Verse Feet

What You Need

Paper and pencil

What You Do

Have your child stand on a piece of paper while you trace their feet. Encourage your child to hop off the paper and then hop back on while you say the verse together.

Say, "In our Bible story today, we learned how Jesus showed love to His friends by washing their feet. Stand on this paper, and I will trace around your feet! Hop off your page. Great job! Now, let's hop back on and say our memory verse together. You can do the motions, too!

"Love each other (*hug yourself*) as I (*point up*) have loved you,' (*point thumbs to chest*)

John 15:12. (Open hands like a book.) Let's do it again!

"Jesus says, 'Love each other as I have loved you.' I'm so glad to know that Jesus wants to be my friend forever. We can love others because Jesus loves us! **Who can love like Jesus? I can love like Jesus.**"

TODAY'S BIBLE STORY

When you love like Jesus, you can be a good friend. WASHING FEET JOHN 13:3-17

MEMORY VERSE

"Love each other as I have loved you." JOHN 15:12, NIV

KEY QUESTION

Who can love like Jesus?

BOTTOM LINE

I can love like Jesus.

BASIC TRUTH

Jesus wants to be my friend forever.



4. WASH THE FEET [LIVE FOR GOD | APPLICATION ACTIVITY]

WHAT YOU NEED: "Feet in Basin" Activity Page; cardstock; crayons; sandwich-sized zip-top bags; blue paper shreds; clear tape; and a permanent marker

WHAT YOU DO:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: Copy "Feet in Basin" on

cardstock, one per child. Write child's name on their paper. Put a small number of shreds in each bag.

DURING THE ACTIVITY: Encourage children to color their paper then help tape the bag of shreds to them. Show children how to move the shreds around as if they were washing the feet.

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: Retell the Bible story.

WHAT YOU SAY:

BEFORE THE ACTIVITY: "Hello, friends! Today, we heard a story how Jesus showed His love for His friends."

DURING THE ACTIVITY: "What's the picture on your paper? (*Pause.*) Feet! Color the feet on your paper. Great job! Now, put this bag over the feet and I will help you tape it to your paper. (*Pause.*) Can you wash the feet on your paper like this? (*Demonstrate.*) Nice!"

AFTER THE ACTIVITY: "In our story today, Jesus' friends had been walking all day on the dusty road. Their feet were really dirty! Jesus wanted to show them how much He loved them, so He washed their feet. Jesus is so important. Jesus is God's Son. You are never too important to love others like Jesus. We can be good friends like Jesus, too! Who can love like Jesus? I can love like Jesus."
